Technical preferences

Talkback mic is a must have!

Hardware:

6x Compressor / Gate FX (reverb & delay) preferably by Lexicon or TC Electronics

Monitors:

Piñata will need at least 5 wedges and 1 drum fill over 5 auxillaries with EQ. Preferably 2 wedges each for the guitar, bass, keys and lead singer and a drum fill for the drummer.

Stage:

Piñata will need a stage (clearance) of at least 5m (wide) x 4m (deep). We need at least 45 minutes to set up. With rolling risers we can shorten the changeover time by preparing backstage.

Riser Drums: $2 \times 2 \times > 0.40$ m Riser Keys: $2 \times 1 \times 0.40$ m

If it's not possible to provide more than 1 (rolling) riser please contact management.

Security:

We've had people falling on stage and the monitors, mics stands smacking the bandmembers and keystands collapsing.

To protect the equipment, the band and the audience we ask the venue to provide crush barriers if the stage is below 1.00 m.

Banner:

Piñata will bring a banner (3x1.35m) with the name and logo of the band to be on stage. There should be one track or truss (3 m) at the horizon of the stage to fasten the banner with rope or tie wraps.



Hospitality rider

Loading / Parking

In order for the band to load-in, load-out and set up smooth and fast a loading spot near the stage is required.

When the cars arrive at the loading area please have 1 or 2 stagehands to help the band and crew to load-in and out and get the gear on stage.

Piñata will travel by 3 cars at most. For the cars we ask the venue to provide enough free parking space.

Dressingroom

One private (preferably lockable) dressingroom for the band + guests provide with:

- Chairs / couches
- Mirror
- Bathroom and toilet in or nearby the dressingroom

On stage:

- Enough bottled water for the band
- 1 crate of beer
- 5 towels

Consumptions:

For the band to prepare as good and comfortable as possible, the dressingroom should be provided with a fridge or coolbox filled with:

- Bottled water, enough for the band, crew + guests
- 2 crates of beer
- 1 Lipton Ice tea
- 1 Apple juice
- 3 1.5L bottle of (Coca) Cola
- 2 1L bottle of Captain Morgan (1 before, 1 after the show)

Enough plastic cups and some fresh fruits and chocolate snacks (such as Mars, Milky Way and M&M's) would be great!

Meals:

Performance after 18:00h:

- 7 Dinners (Healthy, no Chinese, fries or any fastfood)
- Or a buy-out of €15,- x 7

Performance before 18:00h:

21 various sandwiches

Allergy information / preferences:

- 1 meal without fish (except for tuna)
- There are no vegetarians



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Any additional guest musicians/crew members will be reported at the latest 6 hours before the band's arrival.

Dinner can/should be served at least 1h15m before the show, the exact time will be discussed with the (tour-)manager depending on the soundcheck schedule.

If it's not possible to provide a meal, a buy-out of €18,- each member is also possible.

Guestlist:

The band will have at least 15 people to put on the guestlist who will have free access to the event/festival. (This only counts for public events)

Merchandise:

In order to sell merchandise we ask the venue to provide a table/merch-stand for the audience to buy Piñata-merchandise (CD's, T-shirts etc.)

If there are any questions or it's not possible to provide certain facilities/requests from the rider, please contact us for possible adjustments.
