::: ADVANCING THE SHOW :::

Please email rob@electricharmony.com & markbentmusic@gmail.com all venue info and any scheduling as soon as the show is booked. We will email you an advance form to fill out, **please do it**. We appreciate it's boring and tedious but it does serve an important purpose.

::: ADVENTISING & PROMOTIONS :::

Please ask us for any promotional material you require. Don't hesitate to ask, if you need posters or flyer and promo templates, logos or pictures in various file formats. Just get in contact with us.

Please don't just Google some random picture.

::: LEGAL/ IMMIGRATION / PERMITS /FINANCIAL :::

Permits/ visas

It will be promoter's responsibility to obtain all permits required for the show. Please make it clear where permits/visas are required when the show has been confirmed.

Licenses

It will be promoter's responsibility to obtain all required licenses for this show, this includes production licenses for but not limited to, use of smoke, strobes, lasers, radios, IEM's etc.

Taxes

It is very important that any withholding taxes etc. have been discussed with management and

agent and that all efforts are made prior to the show and thereafter to minimize these amounts.

Settlement

During or after performance. Promoter to ensure that all original receipts, invoices and other documentation detailing show costs and show income (including complete breakdown of ticket sales) are available for verification.

Cash payment

Cash payment is to be made on the night. Show fee minus any wired deposit already paid to agent.

::: MERCHANDISE :::

We will be selling merchandise at the show. Please have a table with light available for us to use. Selling merchandise is important to us as it keeps us on the road.

The table must be in a well-lit area near the entrance/exit. Please do not have it hidden in some obscure spot where no one will see it.

::: ACCESS AND LOAD-IN :::

Please make sure there is parking space adequate for one Splitter in close proximity to the stage door.

Dressing room and production office to be accessible 1 hour prior to load in with large bath towels and bottled drinking water supplied.

::: TIMINGS :::

Please allow a **minimum** 3 hours to load-in, set up backline and sound check. Please also allow a strict minimum of 30 minutes for changeover before the band goes on stage.

::: CREW :::

The venue/promoter must provide qualified, sober and English speaking crew.

We are happy to take any advice from house engineers and are happy to work together in making some sense of the noise that will be coming out of our equipment. We are meant to be noisy, if noise is a problem in your venue then please bring it up now as we don't sound good quiet.

FOH engineer please don't be mr grumpy face be mr punky face.

LOCAL CREW / STAFF REQUIREMENTS:

1 x LD from load in until load out
1 x Sound Technician from load in until load out
1 x Promoter representative from load in until load out
2 x Stage Hands (loaders) for load in.

::: BACKLINE :::


