§1 - STAGE

- Minimum 7 by 4 meters raised according to venue size (minimum 30-60 cm).
- Power outlet on stage 230V min. 3 outlets.
- Possibilities to hang a four (4) meters wide by three (3) meters high backdrop behind the artist. (If necessary Backdrop's width can fold to two (2) meters).
- One (1) barstool on stage.
- One (1) clean towel for <u>each musician</u> on stage.
- Three (3) ½-liter (or similar) still water bottles for <u>each musician</u> room temp. (not cold) on stage.

§2 - SOUND

- PA system according to venue size with <u>minimum 15</u>" bass speakers controlled by a professional and certified sound engineer.
- PA system with effects: various reverb, various delay, and various gated reverb.
- Two (2) DI-boxes. (One vocal microphone is going through an on-stage effect processor provided by artist that sends out in stereo (two ¼" Jack)).
- Two (2) DI-boxes for a keyboard if artist brings keyboard.
- Monitor system on stage one (1) for each musician, two (2) for the pianoplayer.
- Microphones and microphone stands to mic up each instrument.
- Two (2) SHURE BETA 87A one (1) at the piano and one (1) on stage.
- Microphone stands on stage: one (1) tripod/boom, one (1) round base for the mic on stage.

§3 - LIGHTING

• Lighting system according to venue size including spots pointed at artists – controlled by a professional.

§4 - SOUNDCHECK

• **IMPORTANT:** The artist must have no less than two (2) full hours on stage for sound check - with fully functional PA and monitor equipment as well as all backline fully functional. Sound check needs to <u>start no later than four (4) hours before Showtime</u>, which will leave two (2) hours for consuming dinner and getting ready for the show.

§5 - SETTING & INTRODUCTION

(N/A for outdoor festivals)

- Audience must be seated during the performance in a concert-like setting facing the artist(s). Food is not to be consumed or served throughout the performance.
- The artist is to be introduced to the audience before show starts. Biography, suggestion for introduction', etc. can be downloaded at: www.chawes.net (go to 'press').

§6 - FOOD, BEVERAGES, etc.

- One (1) meal per musician PLEASE NOTE: of which one (1) <u>vegetarian or fish</u> (*no shellfish*) to be served two (2) hours prior showtime (after sound check).
- Back stage: A decent back stage room for privacy with access to a rest room and a full size (or at least a ¾ full size) mirror with make-up lights.
- One (1) clean towel for each musician on stage (see §1).
- Three (3) ½-liter (or similar) still water bottles for <u>each musician</u> room temp. (not cold) on stage (see §1).

§7 - INSTRUMENTS

[Venue provides the following:]

• PIANO:

One (1) Grand Piano preferable a Steinway or Yamaha (NOT Bösendorfer), newly tuned and in good shape + piano chair with adjustable height. Electric piano models "CLAVIA, NORD PIANO or baby grand look-a-like such as Yamaha GT-Series GT2 might be an acceptable substitute for Grand Piano.

• BASS:

A fine upright bass preferably Eb mensure.

[Bassplayer might bring own instrument if possible. **Please confirm with band!**] A bass cabinet, with minimum 2x10" speakers, and 1/4" connection jacks. (A combo amp of any size <u>not smaller</u> than a "Gallien Krueger – MB 150" is acceptable).

Bass player brings own power amp if bass cabinet is available - **Please notify**.

• DRUMS:

One of the following brands & series: Yamaha Maple Custom, Yamaha Maple Custom Absolute, Yamaha New Club Custom, Yamaha Birch Custom Absolute or Yamaha Oak Custom series.

Tom: 12 x 8

Floor tom (w. legs): 14 x 14

Snare drum (wood, copper or brass): 14 x 5,5

Heads:

Snare: Remo coated ambassador

Toms: Remo coated ambassador on top, clear ambassdors on bottom Kick: Remo coated ambassador on both sides (no port hole in front head)

- Drummer brings own cymbals.

• FLÜGELHORN / TRUMPET:

Horn player brings own instruments.
