- **Drums** are set at **front of stage in reverse**. (cf. stage plan)
- #23: **Trumpet mic** is plugged to the **Keyboarder Submixer** for effects purpose. However, The Clean signal comes from Mixer Direct-out break-out cable.
- Alternatively for smaller Venues, **Channels 18 to 25 can be reduced to 2 channels only**. This brings the the setup down to 20 channels instead of 26.

- -Digital: Midas PRO, Soundcraft Vi and equivalent

### P.A. system

A high quality, 3 or 4 way active PA-system. It has to be configured in STEREO and has to guarantee even coverage, a linear frequency response and sufficient dynamic response (110 dB) over the whole audience area. Subspeakers are recommendet! It is important that the system is free of hum and noise.

Local system engineer must be available for the artist own engineer at all times from sound check to end of concert.

## **Monitoring**

Please provide a 3-way monitoring. 4x wedges (15"/2")
1x drumfill with bass extension
3x EQ (Klark, BSS, ...)

## **Light & Visuals**

Dark & Soft ambiances (Blue, Purple and soft Green) during Dub parts and build ups.

White, Stroboscope, Lasers during heavier parts. Smoke Machine.

Generally, the light mood should be dark, especially to keep the visuals apparent as much as possible, but powerful during the peaks.

## Storage/Parking

In the event the band is staying on site before and/or after the show, the crew must be provided with a **secured storage facility** for gear. The access to this facility must be provided anytime needed. Ideally the production should provide a key. A secured and conveniently placed **Parking-lot** should be kept free untill arrival.

This rider shall help for a smooth and efficient soundheck and show. Please read it carefully and take care that ALL DETAILS are considered and fulfilled. You may also want to provide this technical information to the supplying sound/light company!



## Hospitality rider

**Crew:** 3 to 6 persons ( 3 band members + optional. 3 Tech and merch Crew Members)

Please refer to the Promoter for the actual Crew Size on this particular event.

### **Catering Requirements**

The catering Rider is no requirement that must be fulfilled. It should help you and it works as an orientation. Of course, the crew will be very happy about every point you can realize.

#### At get-in

- Eunlimited hot coffee and tea with milk and sugar (from arrival to departure)
- #Sufficient sandwiches & assorted meats, cheeses, vegetables and other condiments
- Assorted snacks such as crisps, candy bars, nuts, cakes and biscuits etc.

#### • In the dressing room:

-1 crate of good quality local beer

- -1 Bottle of good quality Irish whiskey
- 2 Liters pure fruit juices

- 6 Liters of NON-CARBONATED spring water
- ▲ Liters of assorted soft drinks

#### At least 2 hours before showtime:

Hot, nutritious meals for every crew member.

OR: A cash buyout of (the equivalent of) €20/£20 per person to obtain a hot, nutritious meal, and directions to where one can be obtained locally. Buy out is preferred.

Under no circumstance shall the Artiste be compelled to eat just before the show for whatever reason.

The Artist will have free and unlimited access to high speed internet.

#### **Accommodation:**

A comfortable accommodation for each crew member on the night of the arrangement in the close vicinity of the venue/site. If not realizable, Shuttle or Taxi will be provided free of charge to reach the accommodation site. Hotel is preferred, but Private Accommodation is indeed negotiable.

- -Hotel rooming: to your liking. Separate rooms preferred.
- -Rooms should have separate beds, bath/shower, full breakfast and High Speed Internet access.
- -Should private or in-house accommodation be considered, in all circumstances separate beds, clean sheets and blankets, towels, aptly functioning shower facilities, breakfast and WIFI for each crew members will have to be provided.

### Load-out:

Load-out time should be scheduled upon arrival on Site with the person in charge ( Promoter, Venue Manager etc...)

Note that the Band might need to leave the site outside of the venue opening hours! In this case, access to Backstage and equipment should be provided at any time, including early morning if necessary. THE EQUIPMENT WILL NOT BE STORED IN THE TOURBUS OVERNIGHT IN ANY CASE (see Tech Rider Storage/Parking).
