Quick Overview

We use iPads onstage to wirelessly control 2 offstage computers. The main computer has 8 channels (4 stereo) of audio. The backup computer has 2 channels (1 stereo) of audio.

The main computer also runs HDMI video to a splitter, which is linked to 3 projectors.

Equipment provided by the artist:

- 2 onstage iPads
- 2 side projectors and their HMDI cables
- HDMI splitter
- 2 computers and their respective interfaces (2 channel for backup, 8 channel for main)

Equipment provided by the venue:

- Onstage iPad Table
- Offstage computer table
- House projector (If no house projector exists one of the artist's side projectors can be adapted for this purpose)
- All monitors and house systems
- All connecting cables, snakes, and DI boxes

Onstage

- 2 People play iPads that control a computer offstage.
- The stage must be as naked and free of wires as possible.
- The type of table provided should be discussed beforehand.

Front of House

- Channels 1-8 are stemmed out to allow for greater control of the mix (as opposed to just a stereo signal).
- Channels 9 and 10 should be muted at all times, and quickly unmuted if the main computer goes down.
- There must be a small table near mixing desk to set up computers and interfaces...

Monitors

- Monitor mixes should be the same as house. If the option is available:
 - Player 1should get Left house mix in Upstage monitor and Right house mix in Downstage monitor.
 - Player 2 should get Left house mix in Downstage monitor and Right house mix in Upstage monitor.
- Otherwise a summed house mix in all monitors will do.

Visual

- The house projector must point directly at the stage. The artist provides the two side projectors.
- The venue should notify the artist as to what type of connection the house projector accepts ahead of time.
- All house and stage lights must be turned off other than these projectors.

Equipment provided by the artist:

- 2 onstage iPads
- 2 side projectors and their HMDI cables
- HDMI splitter
- 2 computers and their respective interfaces (2 channel for backup, 8 channel for main)

Equipment provided by the venue:

- Onstage iPad Table
- Offstage computer table
- House projector (If no house projector exists one of the artist's side projectors can be adapted for this purpose)

- All monitors and house systems
- All connecting cables, snakes, and DI boxes
