### THE BAND HAS ALWAYS ALL THE BACKLINE + 1 PRESET MIXER

For smaller venues: the band always carries its own mixing desk (QSC touchMix-8) and only need: an amplifier and its cables (for the mixer), loudspeakers (+cables) and stage monitors. (+cables).

Soho uses her in-ear monitors, connected to the QSC touchMix. The QSC touchMix is located on stage, close to the musicians.
