If you are not working with a professional sound engineer yet and need to recruit one, please consider a professional who has worked a lot within Rock and Hard-Rock genres and ideally knows the venue as well as having experience with the size of your planned show. Please keep in mind that a good engineer and a good sound system will strongly and positively affect the overall experience of your guests.

If you need the band to hire an engineer, a 6th person shall be included in all quantities described in the hospitality rider. Please clarify this with the Management at least 3 weeks prior the show.

Stage:

Minimum stage size: 8 x 5 m Minimum stage height: 1 m Drum riser 3 x 3 m + carpet

PA and FOH:

Must be completely provided and has to suit the venue in terms of power and wattage.


Accountability:
