



## DANCE WITH DIRT

Dance With Dirt is nothing less than a purebred rock band – as shown by winning KarriereKanonen 2012, a prominent music contest on Danish national radio. It takes true grit under the fingernails, heady veins, sweat and moist, to deliver a true and honest rock performance.

Dance With Dirt lives and breathes just to do this, and they are not afraid to evolve in accordance with their intuitive feelings of what rock of this century should sound like.

Their debut album “We Are Dance With Dirt” (Pop-Up/Cargo) hit the streets in February of 2013, and already by the 8<sup>th</sup> week of that year German rollingstone.de chose it as “album of the week”. In March/April the new national Danish youth-channel, DR3, broadcasted the series “KarriereKanonen”, consisting of 8 episodes. The series follows the winners of KarriereKanonen 2012 – Djämes Braun, Kaliber and Dance With Dirt – and their individual musical journeys post-winning and their struggles to break through on the Danish music scene.

Since the victory of KarriereKanonen and the release of their debut album, Dance With Dirt has toured both home and abroad, playing such festivals as Canadian Music Week, Rock For People, Smukfest, Tallinn Music Week, SPOT Festival and recently the band took the new album “Marathon” to the next level, by bringing it forth to an official, blasting truck-stage on the renowned Copenhagen Marathon in May.

“Marathon” (Sony DK/AEM) features DK radio singles “Let Your Fingers Do The Y”, “Snow Machine” and “Heartcase”, and now awaits its European album release in the spring of 2017. Until then, the fall tour '16 lies ahead for the 4 young gentlemen.
