This is a really nice album. When I say nice, I mean exactly that. It's nice in the sense that everything these Frenchmen do is right. In the modern, proggy and somewhat over-produced sense of the word. They got the production right – crisp and clean, the songs are well-crafted. The clean vocals sound good and there's a bit of grunting as well, which more than often keeps me happy. There's a fine balance between pop, rock and aggression, good variation across the album, and generally a lot on offer from Parisians The Long Escape.

Sometimes I'm thinking that this has a lot to do with Sonic Syndicate, however in a slightly softer version, other times I think that there is a strange connection to King's X, both in terms of phrasing and some of the riffing. No matter how strange that sounds, it works for me.

No, this is not going to work for you grindcore purists out there, but then again, what is? For those of you who like music that moves and aren't too concerned about the label we stick on it, try to listen to songs like "The Search" with its amazing bass intro and the cool beat of a song like "Slave". First class, methinks, first class.

The Long Escape - The Warning Signal

Wim: 'The Warning Signal' is the new album from The Long Escape from France. In 2011 they already released the band's debut album ('Triptych') but that album never reached the offices of Lords Of Metal. Fortunately, through this new CD we can still get acquainted with the band around singer / guitarist / composer

Kimo. For 'The Warning Signal' is a strong album by a great band.

After a few listening you do not yet know exactly how you would describe the band. Sometimes that is annoying because the music you hear is just a to incoherent jumble. Well, there is nothing annoying about the music of The Long Distance, on the contrary. It is certainly diverse in terms of styles and the band knows how to vary in tempo as well. But there is also a good ratio of heavy - relaxed. Therefore the music never gets monotonous. True heavy, almost machine-like guitar riffs alternate with Porcupine Tree-like prog rock. And with a different use of his voice Kimo knows to create the necessary differences in emphasis. He roars the lungs from his slender body but he can also sing subdued or know how to sound like a modern, typical American rock band (and that for a Frenchman!). And the vocal harmonies are just brilliant! Furthermore the level of play is very high and that makes all the tracks so exciting and rewarding. Frenzied guitar solos go hand in hand with very surprising twists in chord progressions. Besides the new album of Naive, this is just another very fine French release of internationally advanced level.

Born May 11th 2015, « The Warning Signal » is the second record of Parisian quatuor The Long Escape. An album that gives a cold and digital portrayal of our world. Four years after releasing « The Triptych », the path taken is alarmist and dark. The band has taken the time to deliver a right music in which all lines are gathered throughout a groovy rock metal with a progressive accent.

The songs come one after another and inform us that distress is here. Cries and crashes alert us on our ultra modern societies becoming: The Warning Signal reflects the opposition between natural light and shadow of our hidden lives.

The Long Escape is known for its sound signature tinged by an alloy made of hyper energetic riffs and calm/gloomy passages. Kimo, its frontman says: « we wanted the same cohesion in reading those titles than our precedent effort without forgetting the melody. Everything has to be connected and independent at the same time ».

The Mystery in which lies underneath anticipation, cultivated by the band, adds a significant class to The Warning Signal musical ensemble: what is it about the triangle? Does it have to be compared with the one inversed on the first album? No certainty, the band lets the doubt in suspension...But the parallel with a warning triangle announcing a danger seems like a dreadful self-evident fact. What about the digital lines drawn on concrete blocs and erasing as the sun approaches? Should we read a hidden message filled with hope?

With The Warning Signal, The Long Escape breathes life to a captivating music overflowed with sound diversities and concocts its proper formula. Widely acclaimed by critics, the band will shortly go conquer the crowd and do what they do best: invite the largest number of people to a journey into sound.

Technical Specs

I. Musicians:

Kimo - Lead / Guitar Marius - Guitar / Choir Nico - Bass Tom - Drum / Sample

II. Venues :

It is asked, for each venues, to provide to the band:

- An audio diffusion system adapted to the venue
- An electrical power source with sufficient energy to power up the stage (backline & lights) and control room
- Sound and lights should not be connectd to the same phase to avoid sound degradation
- Power strips conveyanceto stage to power up amps and effects
- The amount of audio cables needed to connect all devices (except musician's cables to connect their own proper devices) in order to insure the good working of microphones and the stage entire audio system
- Secure measures allowing public, artists and devices safety

III. The band's material:

One SM58 mic for lead

Two wireless guitar systems (Line 6)

Two POD HD X for guitars / No amps on stage (if necessary : One 2x12 Cab and one 4x12

Cab with power amp)

Bass Amp: MarkBass 2x12 / RED DI


