### PA

A system in dimensions made to suit location, with contant distortion free power. What companies, how many dBs etc, well, you tell us what's there and we will use it. In case your FOH is NOT positioned at the ideal space (mid of audience, 2/3 distance of room from stage), please let us know. There certainly is a reason for this, and our technician will understand. By the way, of course you will have us not touch your desk wizthout suprvision from your house tec.

Sometimes we travel with our own desk, but don't worry, we are very independent when we do, we're quick and will not cause any extra work for you.

## Monitoring

Please see stageplot and channellist. We'll use what you supply. We do monitors from FOH.

## Soundcheck

Yes, great, we'd love to do one! Even thoughtfully. Your equipment should be already put up and working when we arrive. We love to set up with time and without pressure and then test our sound on stage. If you can offer someone to help us carrying and set up, we accept. If we do not perform by ourselves, please let us know so maybe we are able to check mutual logistics bin advance. And, just to let you know, we can also be really fast with everything, if there is no other way.

#### Lights

A little illumination always is nice. There are numerous possibilities, which are flexible according to the room. Please think "woods", "dark", "Spooky". We will bring a little decoration to underline all this (own shows). A beamer would be grand, we use single but no moving pictures. A little backlight is nice too. For one song we use a strobe. We will probably carry our own. If you can supply a light designer it is important that the cues for changes/blackouts work along to the music. Hazer? Maybe, could work as long as it is not too much, just as a misty forest floor.

## Other:

This rider of course states the ideal, ultimate setting. We do send our requests, you cross out, and together we will have a beautiful result. We are not inventing the wheel a new, as we say.

# If not, please note the following:


- \* If any positions cannot be followed we are sure we can find a solution. Talk to us in advance though!
