Technical Rider

PA: Factory-made and professional quality PA system. The whole sound system should be optimized for the venue and all possible separate sends in addition to the main left and right (front fills, under balcony fills, delay systems, etc.) are to be time aligned and equalized by a competent system engineer. The system must be free of hums and noises and in good working condition at load-in time.

FOH: The band bring our own guitar amps but where possible we will use any available house bass amp and drum kit, we bring breakables. If we are required to provide a drum kit and/or bass this should be advised well in advance. We will need a sound engineer and lighting engineer supplied.

MON: The band will play with stage monitors, in an ideal situation this case we need 5 (five) professional quality wedges (same brand and model) and a separate monitor mixer with a competent English speaking sound engineer to operate it.

STAGE: The size of the stage should be at least 6 x 4 m. If possible, 3 x 2 m riser for the drummer.

LIGHTS: We don't have our own lighting technician so we need 1 (one) English speaking professional to operate lights during the show.

POWER: Our equipment are working on 100-240V AC, 50/60 Hz. We provide all the necessary adapters for each country. All the needed power outlets are shown in the stage plot.

LOAD-IN/SOUND CHECK/LOAD-OUT: We would ideally like 1 hour to load in with a further 90 minutes to sound check. After the show a further hour will be required to pack up and remove our equipment & merchandise from the venue

MERCHANDISE: We would ideally like an area measuring 3 x 2m if possible, we have an expanding metal frame that we display our merchandise on that open up to a height of 2.3m, if this cannot be accommodated please provide an area suitable to display merchandise and enough space for a small table.

OTHER: There is always needed at least 1 (one) competent person with the locally provided or house sound system to be present from the time of the load-in. Also till the end of the show if needed. He/she must have a knowledge of the PA / lighting system and venue in question. We have no DI boxes


Johnny Raspin: Fender Telecaster, a Fender Vibrolux amp, Boss Tuner, an MXR Noise Gate, an Electro Harmonix POG (octave pedal), an Electro Harmonix Pitch Fork (octave pedal), a Marshall Guvnor (distortion pedal), an MXR La Machine (fuzz pedal), a Tremolo pedal, and an MXR Micro Amp (buffer pedal).

<u>Sarah Raspin</u>: Korg Stage Vintage SV-1 keyboard (needs to go through a DI box and has stereo and mono output options), Korg Minilogue synthesiser (needs to go through a DI box)

<u>Ronnie Smith:</u> Fender Jaguar guitar, a Fender Blues Deluxe amp, a Phaser, Tube Screamer (distortion), La Machine (fuzz), Tuner and Noise gate pedals. A spare Ibanez Jet King guitar

<u>Duncan Samwell:</u> Stagg Electric Upright Bass + Ashdown 550 touring combo bass amp

<u>Drummer:</u> Kick Drum, Snare Drum, Rack Tom, Floor Tom, Ride Cymbal, China Cymbal, Crash Cymbal & Hi Hats. 3 Cymbal Stands, 1 hi hat stand Snare stand and Kick pedal

The Thinking Men's travelling party will range between 6 and 9 people, (min 5 band members + 1 member of management team, max = 5 band members, 2 management, 1 x merchandiser, 1 x photographer). We will advise you in advance as to precise numbers.

Back stage rider

- Bottled water x 20

- Snack food to include a Vegan option
- Hot meals for everyone (or cash alternative) with Vegan option

Hospitality

- Clean, dry, well-lit and heated/air conditioned dressing room with chairs, table and mirror
- Clean, dry towels x 5
- A guest ticket provision for every band & management member up to maximum of 7
