An important, but often overlooked factor in the live performance is the sound equipment. Our requirements are simple. We don't need anything utterly expensive or luxurious; just some basic well working gear to serve the purpose. This document is a guideline to the equipment that helps us achieve the best possible performance for the pleasure of the public.

Sound Equipment

We can adapt our performance for several sound systems, but the ideal sound configuration includes the next devices:

- 24 channel sound console with 3 auxiliar sends and channel EQ
- On stage speakers for reference mix to the band. It includes the metronome, voices and music.
- Voice compressor and efects processor (reverb and delay)
- Good microphone system and DI. Examples in the following list.



Auxiliar mix on stage

An auxiliar mix should be send to the monitors on stage which includes the metronome, and also music and voice distributed this way:

- Drums: Metronome + music mix + voice mz
- Male / Female voice: metronome + music mix + own microphone
