A song about determination and the relentless struggle to carve your own path, '**SAVIOUR'** makes use of Jennings' powerful lead vocal coupled with a trance-inducing drumbeat, all wrapped up in a modern and edgy production.

Jennings Couch was born in New York City, raised in rural England and made in the heart of London. While his career is still young, his distinctive sound got him to SXSW 2017 in Austin, Texas, gaining the attention of a wider global audience with shows at The Apple Music House and the BBC British Music Embassy. Jennings then played at the Silk Road Indie Music Festival in Chengdu, China winning the award for 'Best Song in Show'.

Live, Jennings employs pitch-perfect harmonisations and anthemic arrangements that provide fans with rich and varied soundscapes that compare to the likes of The 1975 and Imagine Dragons. His lyrics deal with a range of philosophical, social and scientific ideas from physics to heartbreak and everything in between.

Whilst his music is edgy and modern, Jennings has a passion for the Victorian era. Not only a keen history enthusiast, Jennings is an antique collector specialising in pocket watches. Whether a result of his influences, travels or tendency towards the obtuse, one thing is certain: in an era of copycat faux-musicality, Jennings Couch is a refreshingly unique proposition. In the coming months, he plans to release more singles with accompanying videos and will also be gigging around London to promote the release of 'SAVIOUR'.
