1. Lead Vox	Ollie	LOTS of his vocal, some rhythm guitar, bit of piano
2. Accordion	Miriam	Lots of lead vocal and her vocal, tiny bit of accordion
3. Violin	Dorry	Lots of her vocal, some lead vocal, and violin.
4. Drum Fill	Neil	Lead vocal, rhythm guitar, lead guitar, sampler, and a bit of piano and violin.

The piano player (Jonny) has his own monitor which he controls independently.

The accordion and violin monitors **need** to be independent - if you do not have enough monitors/channels let us know and we may be able to bring extra.
