

### **TECHNICAL RIDER**

(contains 5 pages)

#### STAGE & BACKLINE

A sturdy and dry stage preferably with a minimum size of 6x4m and offering some 230V A/C grounding type outlets. We bring our own backline. Please provide enough mic boom stands (check input list for details). Stagehands are welcome to help setting up the stage for soundcheck! We bring our own XLR cables when on tour, but we still need some additional XLR cables. Please check booking for details.

#### **HOUSE PA SYSTEM**

Any decent professional 3 or 4 ways PA system will be of help, preferably produced by a recognised and professional speaker company such as L-Acoustics, RCF, EV, Turbosound, JBL, Nexo etc. The power of the system should be adequate for the venue size. Make sure it's not distorting, noisy nor otherwise damaged. All information regarding: PA configuration, crossover frequencies and delay times should be provided upon request. Tuning the system using mixer's EQ is not acceptable! Please tune the system using a Loudspeaker Management System.

#### **MONITORING SYSTEM**

If we are playing with drums or any other guest musicians – 1 professional wedge 12-15" for each GUEST musician. Please check booking for details! The band uses it's own wired and wireless EIM systems. Please provide professional wedges 12-15" on "Male Vocals" and "Kaval". See stage plot for details.

#### **FOH**

We bring our own console – Behringer X32 Rack. An UTP cat 5e cable running from FOH to STAGE is needed. On FOH we also need an extra mic stand and a 230V power outlet. Mind that the outputs of the console will be on STAGE! We'd like to patch our outputs directly into the processor/amps whenever possible. Patching through another digital desk is not acceptable!



### SOUNDCHECK

The band requires a minimum of 60 min. to set up the equipment, the instruments and do the soundcheck.

#### **LIGHTS & SCREEN**

Please inform us if multimedia projection is available! When on tour, we bring a 2,5m circular projection screen. It is possible to do video art, when a min. 4000 lumens projector can be provided. Mind that a sturdy truss is required for the rigging of the screen (≈ 30kg) − safety first! If possible, provide: 6xLED Par 7x18W RGBWA+UVA, if possible connect to the house's light universe. Refer to EXTRA LIGHTS PLOT for positioning. A hazer is nice, we love some fog.



## STAGE PLOT




