Backline

Batterie:

1 right-handed drumset- white skins preferred – composed by:

1 bass drum 18 ' and its pedal

1 alto tom 12 'x 08 ' (with attach)

1 floor tom 14 'x14 '

1 snare drum (wooden) 14' x 5,5' on its attach

1 Hi Hat (with its tilter)

3 cymbal feet

1 drums stool

1 carpet 2 x 1 m

The drummer brings his own cymbals

• Piano

A *good* piano ($\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ or upright) (see directly with Rémy for more precisons :+336 64 70 55 74)

Contrabass

Either a woofer 4x10 ' with its amp head (AMPEG, GALLIEN KRUEGER) or a combo Ampeg SVT. Also, be prepared to have a D.I for the bass pickup and a line for the microphone 48V.

Trombone

acoustic option:

a dynamic microphone on its foot for the trombone: RE-20 Electrovoice (preferred) or MD421 Sennheiser, M88, (if nothing else:)SM57 Shure (SM58 would be avoided here).

pedalboard option:

on a other track, the jack line out (Jamman mono, have a spare D.I.)
