Groove based Prog/Funk/Rock/Jazz/World. Warm and fat rhythm section so plenty of kick and bass presence in the room. Percussion is an important part of the sound needs to prominent in the mix. The Sax/ Accordion needs to be as loud as everything else.

LOTS of tom useage so they need to be clear, if not particularly loud. Sharing mics for pairs of toms is possible in smaller venues.

Channels 11&12 Mix the guitars at equal levels most of the time. Dan's guitar has a more earthy tone and Neil's is more twangy. Both have plenty of effects. Neil's guitar **ch13** has a MIDI send **ch14** which needs to be mixed just underneath the guitars (for pads etc) apart from when the MIDI sound takes a Lead role.

Channels 13 and 14 come from the same stereo 4x12 cab with one side housing the guitar and the other the MIDI side of things.
