Technical Rehearsal / Sound Check

A sound check is required prior to performance. The place of engagement shall be ready and available to Artist at the predetermined time. Lighting and sound people (those who will be operating systems for performance) shall be available to do up to two (2) hour complete rehearsal. Systems should be per the attached rider specifications. Bilal's production manager prior must approve any rider changes or substitutions prior to the day of the show. A minimum of two stagehands should be available upon production staffs arrival to load in equipment and reload gear after the performance.

Tour Bus Parking

Parking is need for one 45ft coach tour bus with an attached trailer, total 70ft. Shore power for the bus will be needed. If no designated parking is available, please have meters bagged.

1 – 8ft x 8 ft x 24-inch high riser for Drums


